**WE THE PEOPLE MARCH KICKS OFF SATURDAY
People from Across The World Will March To Stand Up For Democracy**

Washington, D.C. - September 21, 2019 - On Saturday, September 21st, the *We the People March* will take place in Washington, D.C. at 12 PM, with people lining up at Pennsylvania Avenue N.W. between 12th and 13th Streets to march in solidarity past Trump's D.C. hotel and continuing all the way to the U.S. Capitol. The march is a grassroots effort spearheaded by activist and author Amy Siskind, president of The New Agenda, and co-sponsored by concerned citizens and activists from across the U.S. "Finally Americans will have our chance this Saturday to join the world in standing up for democracy," exclaims Siskind.

Numerous *We the People Solidarity Marches* are being held in more than 65 locations across the globe, including Mar-a-Lago, Trump's resort in Florida, and his golf course in Sterling, Virginia. In New York City, people are marching past Trump's network of choice, Fox News. Siskind says, "We have an amazing group of solidarity march organizers around the country who will be marching with us in solidarity at Noon EST on Saturday."

The march is designed to highlight issues that a majority of Americans are deeply concerned about, among them gun violence, kids in cages, the climate crisis, corruption, kleptocracy and human rights violations. Siskind says Americans must take action. "No one is coming to save us. It's time for We the People to march to demand accountability - our democracy and values are at stake," she says.

The *We the People March* will be a day of equity and inclusion that reflects a commitment to peaceful assembly to achieve our mission.
